



Announcement BeneluxCup Deurne-Antwerp 15/3/2025

IDA (Ice Diamonds Antwerp), the first Belgian club uniting figure skaters and shorttrackers, has the honor to invite you to the 4th Benelux competition of the 2024-2025 season, which will take place on Saturday 15/3/2025 at the ice rink in Deurne (Ruggeveldlaan 488, Deurne-Antwerp). The competition is open to all skaters registered and insured with a Belgian, Dutch (Region NBLZ) or Luxembourg Club.

The ice rink has 60cm of rink protection in the curves and 40cm everywhere.

Entry:

Entries should be made by the club secretary via www.shorttrackonline.info, no later than Friday 07/03/2025.

Provisional Program:

- Skater registration between 7h45-8h15
- Warming-up begins at 8h30
- First start at 9h15, end scheduled at 14h
- Prize-giving ceremony (final results Benelux Cup Series) and souvenir planned at 14h30
- The final program will be published on www.ShorttrackOnline.info a few days before the start of the competition. Be sure to check this in advance.

Registration fee:

An entry fee of \in 30,00 must be paid to the organisers for every athlete. To reduce the amount of cash and fast handling, we ask you to wire the money by bank transfer to the organiser bank account no later than Friday 7th of March 2025.

Use the following formatted message with the transfer: "Benelux Club X" the abbreviation of your club on ShorttrackOnline, and X the number of skaters you are paying for. This number should correspond to the number of entered skaters on ShorttrackOnline). For example: Benelux IDA 5. Clubs can only make entries with the approval of their respective ISU Member at: shorttrackonline.info

Helmet Caps:

Helmet caps will be delivered to the team leader/coach at the beginning of the competition. A deposit of €50 in CASH will be requested per club. At the end of the competition, the deposit will be returned when all caps are returned.

Conditions of Contest:

The races will be held according to the all-final system. For all categories there will be a tolerance of one false start. Allocation into the categories will be based on the number of entries. Depending on the schedule, there will be another superfinal and/or relay skating.

Categories:

Junior F: born after 30/06/2015

Junior E: born from 1/07/2013 to 30/06/2015

Junior D: born from 1/07/2011 to 30/06/2013

Junior C: born from 1/07/2009 to 30/06/2011

Junior B: born from 1/07/2007 to 30/06/2009

Junior A: born from 1/07/2005 to 30/06/2007

Senior: born before 30/06/2005

Distances:

Depending on the number of entries, the organizing committee may deviate from this.

- DEF division B: 500m, superfinal 500m
- DEF division A: 500m, superfinal 777m
- ABC/SEN division A and B: 500m, superfinal 1000m

Points will be given according to the agreements made at the Benelux competitions.

Safety:

All skaters must wear cut-resistant accessories such as hand gloves, shin and knee protectors, neck protector and a short track helmet. For more information see: ISU Communication (www.isu.org).

Meals & Drinks:

Bringing your own food in the cafeteria (foodmaker) is not allowed. However, you can order a nice hot meal in 'Foodmaker'.

Liability:

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the KNSB and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance (medical and accident) coverage for their athletes.

Medical Insurance:

It is the sole responsibility of each member, on behalf of its participating clubs, to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such can be requested by the Organizing Committee. See ISU Rule 119.

Parking:

Paid parking next to the ice rink.
