**General Regulations**

The competitions will be held under the 2024 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2649.

Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU Junior World Cup Short Track 2024/25.

## Track Conditions

The **Palaghiaccio** has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. A fully movable protective padding system in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2626 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

## Entries<sup>1</sup>

Entries for this competition will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2649, paragraph 5.

As per ISU Rule 108, participation in the **Juniors division** is open to:

- **Juniors A and B** born in the period 1 July 2005 – 30 June 2009

a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on <https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login>.

b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by **October 3, 2024**

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on **November 4, 2024** (see ISU Communication No. 2649, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:

- Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration Numbers
- Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in
- Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
- Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

d) Competitors must be present in Bormio at the latest at 18:00 hours on Wednesday, November 13 or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Cup Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these

requirements will be excluded

e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries. For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communication No. 1628 or any update of this Communication.

f) A deposit of €50.00 (to be paid in cash) will be required for the transponders.

<sup>1</sup> Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

### **Team Officials Accreditations**

A Video Disclaimer Form must be uploaded in the ORS in the Team Video Specialist' profile prior submitting the Entries. The form is valid for all Events of the season 2024/25.

### **Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure**

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

### **Junior World Cup points**

The points scoring at the Junior World Cup Competition is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2649, paragraph 9.

### **Anti-Doping**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

### **Ice Training**

The Organizing Committee will arrange training sessions from Tuesday, November 12 to Wednesday, November 13 for all participating teams. Each training session (50 minutes) will be charged € 15/pp -. These costs will be invoiced in advance.

Additional dry training possibilities (i.e. weight room, gym, etc.):

During training days and competition days bicycles are at the ice rink and accessible without appointment.

Participants have the option to access Bormio Fitness gym at a cost of €10.00 per person. It is

recommended to use the gym during less crowded times, ideally from the morning until 4:00 PM.

### **Liability**

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Italian Ice Sports Federation and The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

### **Entry Visa Requirements**

Should you need assistance to obtain a Italian entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please contact the Organizing Committee.

### **Accommodation**

All participants should bear their own expenses for accommodation.

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel is as follows:

Single Room (per person, per night, full board):	€ 170,00*

\*Payment: **by invoice in advance**

All arrangements for accommodations must be made through the Organizing Committee by using the attached accommodation reservation file.

Participating ISU Members will be required to arrange a pre-payment of 50 % of the total hotel rooms cost not later than **October 22, 2024**

In case of no-shows or cancellation of hotel rooms after **November 4, 2024** the ISU Member concerned will be charged 80% of the total costs by the Organizing Committee.

### **Transportation**

The Organizing Committee will organize and provide one transportation for each team each way, between Milano Malpensa Airport and the official hotels, from Monday, November 11 to Sunday, November 17.

Transportation will be charged **€ 75,00** per person one way. Participants arriving and departing from other airport(s) or train/bus stations, will be responsible for their own transport costs.

Expenses for team officials, who do not accompany their team members, are to be borne by themselves

The Organizing Committee will also provide transportation between the official hotel and **Palaghiaccio** during the competition days and the training periods, starting from Tuesday, November 12

The date, airline, flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time of departure should be communicated to the Organizing Committee through ORS as soon as possible, but no later than **November 4, 2024**. Please include the amount of special equipment (e.g. bicycles, massage tables, etc.) that needs to be transported.
